Training – library services and databases

Pre-recorded training resources. New to Legal Aid Queensland? View pre-recorded sessions to learn more about the library resources and services you can access.

Databases – criminal law

Criminal judgments. Access a comprehensive collection of criminal judgments to support your legal research and case preparation.

Comparable sentencing decisions. Adult—find decisions from Queensland courts to help you determine a likely range of sentencing options in adult criminal cases.

Comparable sentencing decisions. Juvenile—find decisions from Queensland courts to determine a likely range of sentencing options in juvenile criminal cases.

Databases – family law

Child protection decisions. Gain insights from child protection decisions to better advocate for the interests of children.

Counselling Notes Protect decisions. Access decisions about disclosure of confidential counselling notes.

Domestic and family violence decisions.

Stay informed about decisions discussing principles and issues in domestic and family violence applications.

Family law property decisions. Explore property settlement decisions to help resolve family law property disputes.
